



Boil Water Notice for Community Public Water Systems

(Customers of MHWSC in Hidalgo County residing La Frontera, Alyssa, Cameron #2, Capetillo, Las Palmas, JR #1, JR #2, JR #3, Jesus Maria, FM 1015 Store, Dunn St. and Ford St.)

June 3, 2022

Due to a major break in our 10" main water line, the pressure may have gone below 20 psi which affected our ability to maintain and or delivery water to the system at approximately 5:15pm this afternoon. Military Highway Water Supply Corporation has issued a boil water notice to the following affected area: **Customers in the northeast and southeast of the intersection of FM 1015 and Malone St. The surrounding areas may also be experiencing low water pressure and or possible loss of service.** The water break repairs should be completed by approximately 10:00 pm today. Please conserve water.

The Texas Commission on Environmental Quality has required the Military Highway Water Supply Corporation, PWS ID# TX1080234 public water system to notify all customers to boil their water prior to consumption (e.g., washing hands/face, brushing teeth, drinking, etc). Children, seniors, and persons with weakened immune systems are particularly vulnerable to harmful bacteria, and all customers should follow these directions).

To ensure destruction of all harmful bacteria and other microbes, water for drinking, cooking, and ice making should be boiled and cooled prior to use for drinking water or human consumption purposes. The water should be brought to a vigorous rolling boil and then boiled for two minutes.

In lieu of boiling, individuals may purchase bottled water or obtain water from some other suitable source for drinking water or human consumption purposes.

When it is no longer necessary to boil the water, the public water system officials will notify customers that the water is safe for drinking water or human consumption purposes.

Once the boil water notice is no longer in effect, the public water system will issue a notice to customers that rescinds the boil water notice in a manner similar to this notice.

Please share this information with all the other people who drink this water, especially those who may not have received this notice directly (for example, people in apartments, nursing homes, schools, and businesses). You can do this by posting this notice in a public place or distributing copies by hand or mail.
